volunteers (IVV). This organization was started by a Rotarian from the Antioch Club, who started an eye clinic in Zambia, Africa as a Rotary project. This has grown and is now a non-profit organization. IVV is dedicated to bringing sight and eye care to the impoverished of the world. Since 1995, IVV has been sending teams of eye surgeons and other medical specialists to peaceful, English-

speaking Zambia, one of the poorest countries in the world. The people of Zimba. Zambia, survive on subsistence farming, earning less than \$1 per day, and there is no way they can afford expensive eye surgery.

There are about 100,000 blind people in Zambia, and over 11,000 go blind every year. Most of these people can be cured by modern eye surgery. When the IVV doctors arrive, there are hundreds of patients waiting. Some are blind, some have painful eyes, and some complain of bad vision. In a typical two week mission, the IVV doctors will treat over 700 patients and perform over 150 surgeries. No patient that can be helped is turned away.


