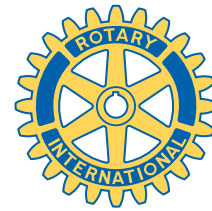

## October 28 Meeting to be Held at Benicia H.S.

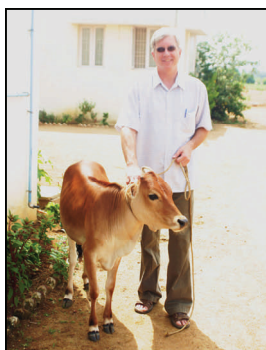
