At Tuesday's Meeting... The many flavors of Olive Oil



Il Fiorello is a family-owned company dedicated to growing and milling the finest quality artisan olive oil. Owners Ann and Mark Sievers produce oil from their own groves. Their properties are located in Green Valley and Suisun Valley between Fairfield and Napa Valley, a still-rural area where creek-side soils allow good drainage for the trees.

The name II Fiorello means "little flower" in Italian, so named after Ann's grandfather,

Dominic Fiorello. She chose the symbolic name for the tiny, white flowers on the olive trees, each of which will become a delicious olive for milling into our ultra premium oil.

Ann is a third generation descendant of "The Chief," Dominic Fiorello, who immigrated to America in the 1860's. The Chief's family traces its roots from Sicily and Sant' Angelo D'alife, a village north of Naples. The Chief passed down a concern for healthy nutrition to his son, Raphael Fiorello, who also relied on traditional practices when providing for his family during the Depression. As Ann grew up, Raphael's homegrown vegetables and grapes helped the family to thrive and enjoy the great pleasures of living close to the land. With the planting of the olive grove, she and husband, Mark, along with daughters, Elisabeth and Katherine, have added their own chapter to the

family saga. Il Fiorello is known for its single varietal oils from Italian, Spanish, French, and Greek varietals.
