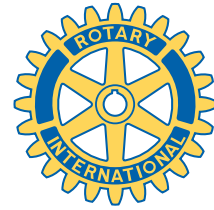

At Last Week's Meeting... Larry Sly, Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano

Do you know about the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano County?

In FY 2012-13, it ...

Served 149,000 people each month
Distributed 16 million pounds of food
Regularly distributes fresh produce as well as
other staples: 1/3 of the food distributed last
year was fresh produce
Uses funds for food programs (95 cents of every dollar
donated went back into food programs)



They provide programs for many different needs:

- ◆ Soup kitchens for daily needs
- ◆ Food pantries: provide three days of food
- ◆ Food assistance programs: food delivered by truck to local distribution centers to help low income households
- ◆ Senior food programs for low income seniors
- ◆ Food for children who are too old for the WIC program
