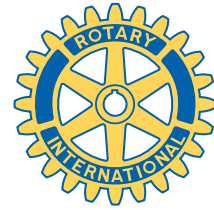

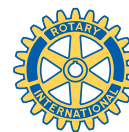

ABOUT THE ROTARY CLUB OF BENICIA

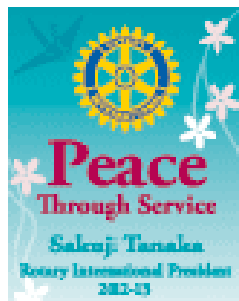
“Celebrating 46 Years in Benicia”
