The Greater Vallejo Recreation District (GVRD) is a Special Service District funded by property taxes to provide recreational activities and leisure services to the residents of Vallejo. The District is run by General Manager Shane McAffee under the oversight of a five member board of directors. The GVRD has served the residents of Valleio

since 1944 independently, but in partnership with, the City of Vallejo. GVRD currently operates 20 neighborhood parks, 4 community parks, 4 special purpose parks, an Olympic-sized swimming pool, 4 community centers and manages over 1000 acres of public land.


