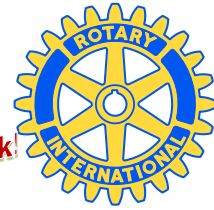

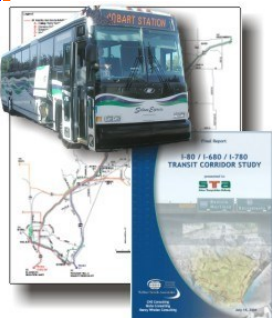


May 5, 2015

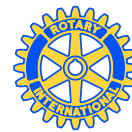

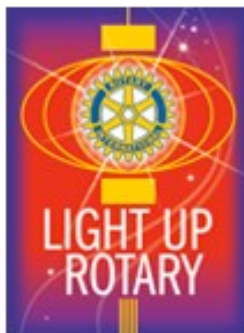
