Darrell Doi was happy as his son has been accepted to the University of Oregon and Oregon State. So at least his son is going to college somewhere.




Alan Schwartzman was happy because his dog is doing well. He didn't want to share all of the "crappy" details with us. Thank you, Alan.


Speakers are needed for January 31 and February 7. Your help is needed!
