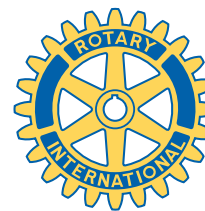

. Principal Joanne Severson talked about Liberty High School. This year's student body is 80-82 students, so the school is close to capacity. Joanne explained that students go to Liberty for a 'host of reasons', and the smaller classes, with a personal touch, help students with no hope to successfully graduate. Liberty has 6 teachers and 7 classes: students need 220 credits to graduate. Liberty HS provides a great example of a few people making an extraordinary difference in the life and future of Benicia students.

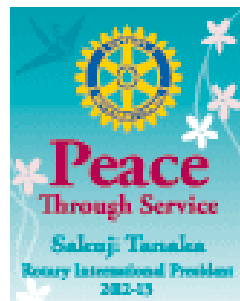
