

Today our speaker was our 2016-17 exchange student from Slovakia – Michal Teraj. Michal is living with Lisa and Matt Koenen, who also joined us today. He gave us an excellent presentation about Slovakia and seemed to enjoy our luncheon! It was great getting to know Michal.

Michal presented an overview of Slovakia. Slovakia is located in the middle of Europe – about 19,000 square miles surrounded by the Czech Republic, Austria, Poland, Ukraine and Hungary. It is mostly mountainous. The capital and largest city is Bratislava. The official language of Slovakia is Slovak, and the country is composed of about 81% Slovaks, 8.5% Hungarians, and 2% Romanians. The country is a parliamentary

democratic republic with a multi-party system. The highest legislative body is the 150seat unicameral National Council of the Slovak Republic. The head of state is the president. Slovakia has been a member of the European Union since 2004. On the following page are some of the pictures that Michal shared with us about Slovakia.
