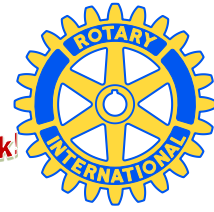

Friends of the Benicia Public Library Book Sales



Carole Nail, President of the [Friends of the Library](#) (Friends), spoke today at the Club. Carole has a long history with the Library, as she was appointed to the Library Board in 1999, served as a Co-Chairman for the successful Measure

L Campaign in 2012, started helping to sell and to sort books for the Friends, and then became President of the Friends in 2015.

Money given to the Library by the Friends is used to purchase books and sponsor programs. Last year, the Library provided over 700 programs, with 13,600 people attending, and most of these were sponsored at least in part by the Friends. The Friends have also funded microfiche processing of back-issues of the Benicia Herald (available through 2012), purchase of e-readers, and buying other emerging technology.

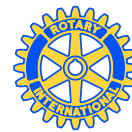

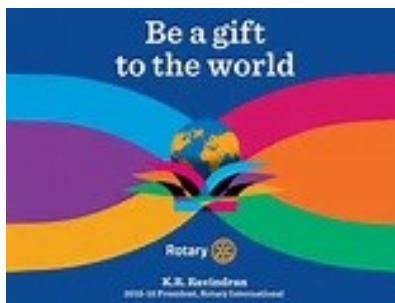
